ORDER:

In the Government Order read above, orders have been issued on the Inspection Scheme for the Factories Division and the Building and other Construction Establishment Division of the Directorate and Industrial Safety and Health.

2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Industrial Safety and Health (FAC) has stated that as on 31.08.2022, there are 48,965 factories in the State. Out of these 2,934 are Fireworks and Match works factories. The number of accidents occurring in the Fire Works Manufactories and Match Factories are on the higher side when compared to the total number of fatal accidents in all factories, hence, the number of inspections in such factories need to be increased so as to ensure the safety of the workers employed therein. Considering the number of accidents and causalities involved in the Fire workers manufactures and Match factories, the Director of Industrial Safety and Health (FAC) has requested that the periodicity of regular inspection has to be modified as once in 6 months irrespective of the number of workers employed therein. He has also sent proposal for amendment of the Inspection Scheme and requested to issue necessary orders for ensuring the safety of the workers employed in Fire Works Manufactories and Match Factories.

3. The Government after careful examination accepts the proposal of the Director of Industrial Safety and Health (FAC) and issues following amendments to the orders issued in G.O. read above.

<u>Amendment No-1</u>

(i) In the G.O. read above under the heading "A. Factories Divisions", under 'High Risk Category' for the Clauses 1(b), 1(c) as shown in column (A) of the table below, the following clauses as shown in the column (B) shall be substituted and clause 1(d) shall be inserted after Clause (c) as in column (B) of the table below: -

- (ii) In the G.O. read above under the heading "A. Factories Divisions", under High Risk Category' for the words "These factories shall be randomly inspected once in a year" the following words shall be substituted, "The High-Risk Category of factories mentioned in sub-clause (a), (b) & (c) shall be randomly inspected once in a year and factories mentioned in sub-clause (d) shall be inspected once in 6 months".
- (iii) In the G.O. read above under the heading "A. Factories Divisions", under 'Medium Risk Category' for the Clauses 2(a) & 2(b) as shown in column (A) of the table below, the following clauses as shown in the column (B) shall be substituted:-
